Re: A46 M5 junction 9 to Teddington Hands roundabout resurfacing

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming maintenance works on the A46, near Tewkesbury. This work will be carried out by our contractor, Kier, on our behalf.

What we're doing and why? What are the benefits?

We'll be resurfacing the A46 between M5 junction 9 and Teddington Hands roundabout. The work has been identified following the deterioration of the carriageway. We'll also be replacing the road markings and road studs. The completed work will provide a smoother surface and safer road, including clearer road markings.

When will this work take place?

We'll work from **8 February 2021** to **19 March 2021**. Our work will be carried out overnight when traffic counts are lower between **8pm** and **6am, Monday to Friday**. To reduce disruption to customers, the work will be delivered in phases as follows;

Phase 1 - 8 February to 26 February, the A46 will be **closed** between A46/B4079 Aston Cross and Teddington Hands roundabout.

Phase 2 - 1 March to 11 March, the A46 will be **closed** between Northway Lane and A46/B4079 Aston Cross.


Phase 3 – 12 March to 19 March, the A46 will be **closed** between M5 junction 9 and Northway Lane.

Please be advised that we have a contingency week allocated from 22 March to 26 March due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances. If required, we'll provide updates using the black and yellow signs at the side of the road, and also our A46 bulletin.

What does this mean for you

Access to businesses and frontages that fall directly within our works area (see above), will be facilitated via the use of marshals and escort vehicles. This will ensure added safety to both the road user and workforce at all times.

During closures, we'll provide a fully signed diversion route. We would request that all diverted traffic follow our diversion route. Emergency vehicles will have access throughout our works.

I'd also like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption to those living close to the work. We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise levels and additional lighting to minimise the impact.

All our sites have strict safeguarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID19 and none of our sites are open to the public. All major construction projects are closely monitored, and the situation is kept under constant review
