

## Warndon Parish Council SID report covering Mar 2023 for April Meeting

### TRAFFIC ANALYSIS REPORT FOR WESTCOTEC SID

The Westcotec machine has been returned from Westcotec with its solar power unit fitted, so both the Parish Council speed signs will have solar capability. The device has been installed on Dugdale Drive on lamppost 7920 opposite Bright Avenue for vehicles heading west. This location has a history of a large proportion of vehicles exceeding the 30mph speed limit.

Encouragingly compared to the historical data below the proportion of speeders and the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speeds are lower than in 2022. The numbers, however, are still too high and compare less favorably to the Incoming vehicles around 11% on Millwood Drive and 10% on Plantation Drive. Outgoing vehicles are another matter, and the Westcotec SID does not capture these.

The Westcotec report that accompanies this Parish Report provides more detailed information regarding driver behaviour.

## TRAFFIC ANALYSIS REPORT FOR ELAN CITY SID

The newly purchased SID is manufactured by Elan City and uses its own software that is different to the Houston Radar software on the Westcotec device the Parish Council has also uses.

The device was repositioned from 23/02/2023 on Millwood Drive, on lamppost 7791, for vehicles travelling south just before Turbary Avenue.

The table below summaries the data captured by the device. Regrettably there has been a slight increase in the proportion of drivers speeding. The highest speeds recorded are 73mph incoming (facing the sign) and 88mph outgoing. The Elan City report that accompanies this Parish Report provides more detailed information regarding driver behaviour.
